We recently sent you a Request for Letters of Interest on the above-mentioned specification.

This Addendum Number 2 provides for:

## **Clarifications**

1. Is the expectation that the full scope of work identified in the RLI will be performed for the \$335,500 budget?

Response - The County is aware of the budget limitations and is seeking funding to supplement shortfalls associated with project design and permitting. The firm should present a complete scope of work the firm determines will be necessary to effectively and efficiently design, permit, and implement the project.

- 2. Under 6. Project Approach, Estimated Project Costs, there is reference to "additional funding sources are being identified and secured."
  - a) What are the additional funding sources and when are those sources expected to be available?

Response - The County is evaluating several funding opportunities. Escambia County has allocated all of its RESTORE Pot 3 allocation to the Bayou Chico Contaminated Sediment Remediation Project. Funding can be used for design and implementation. The Gulf Consortium nor RESTORE Council have approved a grant award, as such a schedule cannot be provided at this time.

b) Does this refer to additional funding sources for this scope of work?

Response - Yes.

c) Does the additional funding sources refer to project implementation?

Response - Yes.



- 3. Deliverable 1(b), Attachment A, Grant Work Plan, requires (in part): "submit(al) of electronic copies of the chemical analysis of sediment to be used to determine appropriate handling and disposal methods...." Does the County have an opinion on how may samples it wants to have analyzed?
  - Response The County will rely on the expertise and experience of the firm, in consultation with state and federal permitting agencies, to determine the number of samples required to adequately quantify and qualify contaminated sediment within the project area and meet the requirements to successfully obtain all necessary permits.
- 4. The RLI includes Tasks, budget category and budget amount (see page 69/159). Upon what assumptions is the budget based?

Response - Funding allocated by the RESTORE Council was negotiated and approved by the State of Florida.
