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## I. INFORMATION PACKAGE

### Engineering Design Services for Robinson Street, Dirt Road Paving and Realignment Project

Solicitation Identification Number PD21-22.008

#### Scope of Work:

Escambia County Engineering is soliciting for engineering services to develop plans for a roadway realignment and drainage system on the unpaved portion of Robinson Street as part of our Dirt Road Paving Program (DRP). Robinson Street is located in Commissioner District 5 in Cantonment, Florida.

The existing dirt road begins at Taylor Street continuing North until the end which is approximately 3,900 LF or 0.74 Miles. It is the intent of the county to acquire a 50' right of way in which to construct a 24 ft roadway with drainage system. The North end shall have a turnaround consisting of 90-foot diameter asphalt within a 100-foot diameter right of way. Realignment of Robinson St. at Taylor Street is proposed to align the roadway with the current paved portion of Robinson Street. The selected consultant shall provide Escambia County a complete design package. The selected consultant shall be responsible for generating certified boundary and topographical survey that meets current minimum technical standards as defined by applicable Florida Statutes and provide associated legal descriptions for Right of Way (ROW) acquisition. The firm shall provide construction plans, permitting, public involvement as needed, bid documents, with limited construction oversight for this project.

#### Description of Work Activities:

The consultant and/or sub-contractors may perform the following activities in the completion of construction plans.

Task 1: Data collection and review, Plan preparation, Permitting and ROW Acquisition documents:

- Attend public meetings with residents to receive input from residents regarding drainage and acquisition issues.
- Provide Geotechnical reports on soil data.
- Coordinate with County Surveyor and staff for the collection of data for the project and provide additional survey as needed.
- Provide 30% plans for Real estate acquisition, 60% and final plans for County review.
- Provide for all required regulatory permitting including permit fee allowances.
- Plans should be reproducible to 40 scale 11"x17" and 20 scale 24" x 36" sheet size plans and AutoCAD.
- Utility Coordination and plans-in-hand walk through with Utility companies.
- Submit probable cost estimate at each phase submission.
- Prepare legal descriptions and sketches for County ROW acquisition.

Task 2: Bidding Estimates:

- Prepare Bid documents through the bidding process.
- Attend pre-bid meeting with Engineering and Purchasing Departments.
- Respond to all Request for Information and issue any addendums.
- Tabulate bids or pricing agreement totals.

Task 3: Construction Administration and Inspections:

- Attend Pre-construction conference
- Prepare As-Built certification based upon contractor mark ups and post construction inspections.
- Consultant will be available on an as needed basis during construction to address issues with design or any unforeseen construction issues.

Information submitted with your letter of interest should include documentation to demonstrate your firm's qualifications and abilities to provide the scope of services. A committee will review the information submitted and short-list the firms. On-site presentations, interviews, and or discussions will be requested of a short list of three or more firms. Once all review is complete, the short-listed firms will be ranked by the selection committee with the top ranked firm being scheduled for negotiations.

**B. CONDUCT OF PARTICIPANTS**

After the issuance of any solicitation, all bidders/proposers/protestors or individuals acting on their behalf are hereby prohibited from **lobbying** as defined herein or otherwise attempting to persuade or influence any elected County officials, their agents or employees or any member of the relevant selection committee at any time during the **blackout period** as defined herein; provided, however, nothing herein shall prohibit bidders/proposers/protestors or individuals acting on their behalf from communicating with the purchasing staff concerning a pending solicitation unless otherwise provided for in the solicitation or unless otherwise directed by the purchasing manager.

**Definitions**

***Blackout period*** means the period between the time the bids/proposals for invitations for bid or the request for proposal, or qualifications, or information, or requests for letters of interest, or the invitation to negotiate, as applicable, are received at the Escambia County Office of Purchasing and the time the Board awards the contract, and any resulting bid protest is resolved, or the solicitation is otherwise canceled.

***Lobbying*** means the attempt to influence the thinking of elected County officials, their agents or employees or any member of the relevant Selection Committee for or against a specific cause related to a pending solicitation for goods or services, in person, by mail, by facsimile, by telephone, by electronic mail, or by any other means of communication.

**Sanctions**

The Board may impose any one or more of the following sanctions on a nonemployee for violations of the policy set forth herein:

- (a) Rejection/disqualification of submittal
- (b) Termination of contracts; or
- (c) Suspension or debarment as provided in Sec. 46-102 of the Escambia County Code of Ordinances.

This policy is not intended to alter the procedure for Protested Solicitations and Awards as set forth in the Sec. 46-101 of the Escambia County Code of Ordinances.

**C. IDENTIFICATION OF SUBCONSULTANTS/CHANGES AFTER THE FACT**

After delivering an initial proposal in response to this solicitation, all submitters are prohibited from substituting, modifying, or amending those subconsultants identified in the initial written submittal at any time during the course of the solicitation process up to the final award of contract and including question and answer sessions, presentations or technical clarifications and submittals as may be required by the Review/Selection Committee. A substitution or addition of subconsultants or any other material changes to the submittal after the initial response will cause the submittal to be invalid for review and selection purposes.
